

- March ELL Codes Update will need to be completed (students who have moved, who have come). They will use the same document as in the fall and SSFs will be asked to update the information


- Next ELL Benchmark Assessment is to be completed by May 15th

- Technology RWGoogle Extension
- Translators
- Graphic organizers
- Pre-teach Vocabulary
- Vocabulary in Context/Vocabulary notebooks
- Tap Prior Knowledge
- Focus on the big Ideas/Concepts
- Grammar in context and at appropriate level
- Journal writing/write in first language for some tasks
- Cloze activities
- Encourage extensive reading at their level
- Cultural connections
- Games/puzzles



- There are some concerns regarding SSFs diagnosing reading disabilities or dyslexia

6.Assessment Go Forward Plan - Kathy Murch

Things to Consider:

- Assessments need to be administer in a timely fashion & standardize the testing procedure for accuracy need to be developed
- There is a need for both Reading & Numeracy assessments

- SSFs will need to lead this process in the school & therefore, a presentation needs to developed and shared at the next SSF Meeting
- So Now What or What Next?
- As a Division, we need to provide teachers with Professional Development on instructional approaches to remediate Reading difficulties that have been identified using the Fountas & Pinnell
- We need a committee to explore the following:
 - a) Early learning Tool
 - b) Different Level B Assessment than WJIII (WIAT & KeyMath)
 - c) Level A testing like CAT-IV & STARS (Whole School Screening)
- Rita Steele, Wendy Weis, Catherine Meehan, Diane Lynch, Daniel Ceresna, Liane Huson will form a committee and report back at June 4th SSF Meeting

7. Professional Development for next year - Kathy Murch

- To be tabled until next meeting (June 4th)
- Options could include team building, POPARD, RTI, Restorative Justice, Mental Health Issues, Wellness

8. IPP Feedback - Diane Sell & Bhavna Rao

- SSFs are asked to provide feedback for the IPP template that was shared by Diane & Bhavna
- Cochrane, Rocky View, Parkland, Ontario are using these templates
- Kathy is looking at what IPPs we will be using next year
- Options could include using *PowerSchool* IPP module, customizing IPP template in *PowerSchool* or using another program or template not related to *PowerSchool*
- We will revisit this topic in the coming months

9. TA Allocations - Kathy Murch

- Be prepared, budget will be smaller
- Looking at only supporting the most significant students next year
- Student Learning Profiles will be used again to determine TA Allotments for the 2015-2016 school year
- 1:1 Students will only be granted if there is danger to self and others or student needs support for medical reasons
- A suggestions was made to add clustering information or Current Level of Support on to Student Profile
- SSFs should complete a Student Learning Profile for any student who are on an IPPs, behaviour plan, or at risk & require support
- No 1:1 Applications will be required this year

10. High School Transition to Adulthood/developing protocol - Kathy Murch

- Kathy would like to form a committee of SSFs to look into this issue so that a standardized process can be developed across the division
- Geoff Barnes, Bhavna Rao & Alana Baxter will work together to look at this issue and report back at the June 4th SSF Meeting

11. Red File Documentation Standards - Kathy Murch

- Revisit in June as Kathy will get direction from Wild Rose Administration team
- SSFs need to review the document shared for accuracy
